

2009 QUADRANT SCHEDULE


Dear Resident:

The City of Syracuse is sending you this card as a reminder.

Yard waste & construction debris must be limited to two (2) cubic yards each. Call and advise City Line—448-CITY (2489) one week in advance for construction debris set outs only. As a resident of the **NORTHWEST** quadrant, you are allowed to put yard waste and construction debris between the sidewalk & curb, not in the street, on the weekends listed below **ONLY**. Pick up will be during the weeks that follow.

April 25-26 May 23-24 June 27-28 July 25-26

Aug. 22-23 Sept. 26-27 Oct. 24-25



- Yard waste includes **BRUSH, BRANCHES & LEAVES**. Leaves should be in a separate pile. (**NO PLASTIC BAGS**)
- Yard waste cannot be set out prior to **Saturday** morning and no later than **Sunday** evening (**APRIL—OCTOBER ONLY**)
- Yard waste must be set out neatly between the sidewalk & curb, not in the street, and not near sewer vents, fire hydrants or poles.
- **DO NOT** place yard waste or construction debris in plastic bags, boxes or cans.
- **SEPARATE** yard waste from construction debris and keep household trash **SEPARATE**.
- Debris generated by a private contractor must be disposed of by the contractor. The City will not pick it up.
- For construction & demolition debris pickups, you must call 448-CITY (448-2489) one week prior to your pick up.
- During the season (April through October), you are allowed no more than two (2) cubic yards each. (About the size of a washer & dryer side by side)

Failure to comply with the above rules may result in a citation being issued by the Division of Code Enforcement.
