**CITY OF SYRACUSE ISSUES A WEEKEND TRAFFIC
ADVISORY FOR THE SHAMROCK RUN**

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – The City of Syracuse Department of Parks, Recreation, and Youth Programs has issued a traffic advisory in advance of the annual Shamrock Run, which will be held on Saturday, March 7, throughout the Tipperary Hill Neighborhood.

Coleridge Avenue will be closed from approximately 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon between Lowell Avenue and Avery Avenue to facilitate a safe lineup for runners.

There will be intermittent traffic disruptions along the race course on Coleridge Avenue, Avery Avenue, Tompkins Street, Ulster Street, Cayuga Street, Hamilton Street, Milton, North and South Lowell, and Wilbur Avenues.
