**CLINTON SQUARE TREE DELIVERY TO TAKE
PLACE ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 9**

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – The City of Syracuse Department of Parks, Recreation, and Youth Programs announced today the tree which will serve as the centerpiece for the City's annual Home for the Holidays celebration in Clinton Square will be cut down and delivered on Monday, November 9. The City's annual Home for the Holidays program will take place on Friday, November 27 at 6:30 p.m.

The tree is being donated by Ms. Kathleen Shaw. The tree is on property located at 707 Shaver Avenue in North Syracuse. Crews will arrive on scene around 8:00 a.m. to begin cutting the tree down. The tree's anticipated arrival in Clinton Square will be shortly after 11:00 a.m.

The route of travel will be 707 Shaver Avenue to Gordon Road, to Bear Road, to Route 481 South to Route 81 South to the Salina Street exit to Clinton Square.

JPW Structural Engineering and JPW Erectors will provide technical support in the process.
