**CLINTON SQUARE TREE TO BE DELIVERED ON FRIDAY,  
NOVEMBER 3**

*Tree is the Centerpiece of the City's Annual "Home for the Holidays" Celebration  
in Clinton Square*

*Tree Donated by Cicero-North Syracuse High School*

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – The city of Syracuse Department of Parks, Recreation, and Youth Programs announced today that a tree has been selected for Clinton Square and will be delivered to Downtown Syracuse on Friday, November 3. The 60-foot tree was donated by the North Syracuse Central School District and is located at Cicero-North Syracuse (CNS) High School and will be transported by JPW Erectors, which is donating their services to the city.

City crews will cut and transport the holiday tree from Cicero North-Syracuse High School to Clinton Square Friday, November 3 beginning in at 9 am. Traffic will be impacted along Route 31, between CNS and the entrance ramp to Route 81 South, Route 81 South to downtown Syracuse. South Salina Street, from West Genesee Street and Washington Street, will be closed to traffic from late morning to early afternoon, while the tree makes its approach to the Square and is hoisted into place.
