The Notice of Eminent Domain Procedure Law Public Hearing and Notice of Availability of the Design Approval Document was published in the Syracuse Post-Standard on June 26, June 28, June 30, July 3, and July 5, 2016 with respect to the above project. A second public hearing announcement was published in the Syracuse Post-Standard on July 21, July 24 and July 26, 2016. The Notice and announcement both stated that a public hearing would be held at the Southwest Community Center, 401 South Avenue, Syracuse, NY 13204 at 7:00 PM on July 26, 2016.

The City of Syracuse also provided announcement of the public hearing through:

- Mailing of the meeting announcement to 7,000 property addresses in the project area.
- Announcement of the meeting on the City of Syracuse homepage for two weeks prior to the meeting and providing project documents on the Creekwalk webpage.
- Email of the meeting announcement to affected property owners, local organizations, public information meeting attendee list, elected city officials and City Department commissioners.
- Certified mailing of the hearing announcement to all affected property owners.

I hereby certify that the hearing was held at the location indicated, all material presented was duly recorded and full reconsideration has been given to the economic and social effects of the location, its impact on the environment and its consistency with the goals and objectives of such urban planning as has been promulgated by the community.

This hearing followed the "open forum" format. Copies of the transcripts, brochures and pamphlets, photos and/or depictions of displays, presentation summaries, etc. that document that this public hearing conformed to the regulations are attached to the copy of this certification being transmitted to FHWA.
