MAYOR ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT OF NEW DEPUTY COMMISSIONER

*Stephanie Pasquale Will Serve as Deputy Commissioner for
Neighborhood and Business Development, Assisting Syracuse
Residents in Housing Issues and Coordinating CDBG Funding*

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – Mayor Stephanie A. Miner announced today that Stephanie Pasquale will join her administration as Deputy Commissioner of Neighborhood and Business Development. She will begin her position on July 15. The Deputy Commissioner has direct oversight of the Neighborhood Division within the Department of Neighborhood and Business Development but will also have general oversight of all aspects of the department: Neighborhood, Business, Lead Remediation, Codes Enforcement and Fiscal affairs.

“I am proud to welcome Stephanie Pasquale to our team,” said Mayor Miner. “She has an excellent record of accomplishment and she will be a strong asset for the people of the City of Syracuse as well as for my administration.”

Stephanie R. Pasquale most recently served as the Deputy Executive Director for Home Headquarters, Incorporated. In that role, she worked on the oversight of program design and development and played a large role in the administration of the HomeOwnership Center. She also has previous experience working as a Loan Fund Director for Worcester Community Housing Resources in Massachusetts and doing Community Development Consulting. She is a graduate of Syracuse University and holds a Master of Public Administration degree from the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs at the school.
