ARTSWEEK STREET CLOSING ADVISORIES

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – The City of Syracuse announces the Northeast Jazz and Wine Festival, the Blue Rain EcoFest and the AmeriCU Arts & Crafts Festival will be held throughout downtown Syracuse next weekend, prompting some street closings.

The Arts and Crafts Festival in the Columbus Circle area runs Friday, July 26, through Sunday, July 28. The following is the schedule of street closings and some alternative traffic routes:

- The 200 through 400 blocks of East Jefferson Street will be closed from 5 a.m. Friday, July 26, until Monday morning, July 29
- The 300 and 400 blocks of Montgomery Street will be closed from 5 a.m. Friday, July 26, until Monday morning, July 29
- The 100 and 200 blocks of East Onondaga Street will be closed from 5 a.m. Friday, July 26, until Monday morning, July 29.

The Northeast Jazz and Wine Festival is in Clinton Square on Friday, July 26, and Saturday, July 27. Due to the Northeast Jazz and Wine Festival the following streets will be closed:

- The 100 block of West Water Street will be closed from Thursday afternoon July 25, through Sunday morning, July 28.
- Erie Boulevard West, between Clinton and Franklin Streets, will be closed at 6 a.m. on Friday, July 26, through Sunday morning, July 28.

- Clinton Street, from West Genesee to Washington Streets, will be closed at 6 a.m. on Friday, July 26, through Sunday morning, July 28.
