### Syracuse Hancock International Airport and C&S Companies Receives Awards for the Terminal Security and Access Improvement Project

**Syracuse, New York** – The City of Syracuse and Syracuse Regional Airport Authority are pleased to announce that the Syracuse Hancock International Airport has received three awards for the Terminal Security and Access Improvement Project that was completed in 2013.

“These awards demonstrate that the Syracuse Hancock International Airport is on the cutting edge of airports across the country,” said Syracuse Mayor Stephanie A. Miner. “We are lucky to have the best aviation management team available working here in Syracuse and these awards recognize their efforts.”

Previously this year the Airport was awarded a Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED) rating of Gold for the Passenger which was completed in May 2013. “Gold” is the second highest rating for LEED standards. LEED is a green building certification program best-in-class building strategies and practices. The Terminal Security and Access Improvements project received this certification for energy use, lighting, water and material use, as well as incorporating a variety of other sustainable strategies.

Additionally, during last month’s New York Aviation Management Association (NYAMA) Fall Conference, the Airport as well as C&S Companies was presented with “The Phil Brito Project of the Year Award.” The award was established to recognize airport sponsors and their engineering and consultant teams for outstanding achievement in the execution of an aviation-related planning, design, or construction projects for airports located within the State of New York.

And lastly, the Airport and C&S Companies were awarded the “ACEC New York Gold Award for Engineering Excellence” in the Transportation Category. Each year, over 60 firms submit projects that are judged on a rigorous set of criteria, which includes complexity, innovation and value to society.
