MINER ANNOUNCES AN EARLY OPEN TO CLINTON SQUARE ICE RINK

*Due to Cold Temperatures, Popular Downtown Rink Set to Open
Friday, November 21*

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – Mayor Stephanie A. Miner announced today that, in response to colder than anticipated weather, the Clinton Square ice rink will open for the 2014-15 season on Friday, November 21.

“We are pleased to announce this early opening as a benefit of some colder-than-normal Syracuse weather,” said **Syracuse Mayor Stephanie A. Miner**. “The Clinton Square ice rink attracts visitors from across Upstate New York and we encourage Syracuse skaters to come enjoy the extra few days we will now have with the rink.”

The rink opening was made possible due to a stretch of lower than anticipated temperatures in the Syracuse area. The rink was set up in the previous weeks with painting and “flooding,” the filling of the rink with water to make ice, took place on Tuesday, November 18.

There is no increase in rates for this skating season. General admission is \$3.00. Skate rental is \$3.00. Admission for children under 12 and seniors over 55 is \$2.00. The rink will be open on Friday from 11:00 am to 8:30 PM. Full rink hours can be viewed on the Parks Department website at www.syr.gov.net/parks.
