## **CITY ANNOUNCES PUBLIC MEETINGS SCHEDULED FOR SECOND PHASE OF ONONDAGA CREEKWALK**

*Three Meetings Held Throughout the City to Give the Public an Opportunity to Comment on Design Options for Phase II of the Popular Onondaga Creekwalk*

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – The City of Syracuse will hold public information meetings to gather public input as they undertake the preliminary design process for the second phase of the Onondaga Creekwalk. The proposed second phase of the Creekwalk will extend 2.2 miles, from Armory Square to West Colvin Street.

“The first phase of the Onondaga Creekwalk has been a great success and we welcome the opportunity to plan for this expansion,” said **Syracuse Mayor Stephanie A. Miner**. “These community meetings will allow the most important stakeholders—our neighbors—to have a voice in the process for this growing asset.”
