MINER PUTS FOCUS ON INFRASTRUCTURE IN TESTIMONY BEFORE NYS LEGISLATURE

*Miner Used Annual Appearance Before Joint Legislative Budget
Hearing on Local Government To Urge Leaders To Make Funding
Water Infrastructure a Priority*

*Miner: Providing Clean Water is a Fundamental Service of Local
Government*

ALBANY, N.Y. – Mayor Stephanie A. Miner used her appearance today before the Joint Legislative Budget Hearing on Local Government to urge leaders to put make infrastructure investments a priority in the state budget.

“This is an important opportunity to tell our legislators in Albany that infrastructure is a priority for the City of Syracuse,” said **Syracuse Mayor Stephanie A. Miner**. “A key component of infrastructure is the delivery of clean water. This is a fundamental service of local government and is a key building block to economic and community development. “

Mayor Miner used her testimony to highlight infrastructure issues in the City of Syracuse and the need for a partnership with the State of New York to address them. Specifically, she focused on water infrastructure and detailed how the City of Syracuse had 391 water main breaks in 2014 and 2,109 breaks between 2004 and 2014.
