SYRACUSE, N.Y. – Mayor Stephanie A. Miner announced today that city pools in Burnet Park and Thornden Park will open on Saturday, June 21 for the season. The Schiller Park pool will open on Sunday, June 22 for the season. Additional pools in the City of Syracuse Parks and Recreation system will open during the following week on June 29.
