First Bicycle Infrastructure Master Plan Public Meeting July 13

Syracuse, NY – The City of Syracuse is developing a Bicycle Infrastructure Master Plan and will hold its first public meeting on Wednesday, July 13 at 8:30 a.m. at the City Hall Commons Atrium as part of the monthly F.O.C.U.S. CNY Pathways meeting. The City will be presenting a draft of cycling corridors, bike lane treatments and recommendations for bicycle parking. These corridors have been identified through a rigorous 13-metric system. The bicycle lane and bicycle parking treatments will be based on national and international models that are compatible with Syracuse's climate. The City is looking for public feedback to verify its inventory and for comments on the models the City is proposing.
