City of Syracuse Seeks Public Input on Draft Sustainability Plan; City-wide Public Meeting May 30

Syracuse, New York – The City of Syracuse Bureau of Planning & Sustainability released its draft Sustainability Plan for public comment today.

Five advisory teams made up of local experts and City personnel developed the five chapters of the plan, which include: **Energy & Green Building, Waste & Recycling, Natural Environment, Food Systems, and Education.**

The City will also host a City-wide public meeting to discuss the Sustainability Plan in further detail on **Wednesday, May 30 at 5:30 p.m. in the City Hall Commons Atrium**, 201 East Washington Street.

The Bureau of Planning & Sustainability has begun to share the draft with neighborhood Tomorrow's Neighborhoods Today (TNT) groups this month. The public is invited to learn about the plan, ask questions, and share their ideas for making a more sustainable Syracuse at the following neighborhood Tomorrow's Neighborhoods Today (TNT) meetings in May and June:

May 23, 7 p.m., TNT Area 7, Northside - Grant Middle School, 2400 Grant Blvd.

June 12, 7 p.m., TNT Area 5, Eastside - IT Central (former Levy School), 111 Fellows Ave.

June 13, 5:30 p.m., TNT Area 1, Downtown & TNT Area 8 Lakefront - City Hall Commons Atrium, 201 E. Washington St.
