1. **The Armory** - Armory Square trailhead
2. **The Warehouse** - Fayette St.
3. **Rumble of Trains** - base of limestone wall/ramp
4. **The Original Washington Station** - Wash. St. Garage
5. **Niagara Mohawk Building** - Compass Rose park
6. **The Old Red Mill** - Old firehouse on W. Genesee
7. **Coal Dust and Smokestacks** - Franklin Square, Plum St. bridge
8. **Remnants of Railroads** - Old railroad bridge near Maltbie St.
9. **Mineral Springs and Baths** - Parks Dept./stone barn
10. **A Harbor for Syracuse** - Inner Harbor near amphitheater
11. **A Sea of 'Solar Salt' Sheds** - Platforms near Hiawatha Blvd.
12. **A Sacred Lake** - lakeshore
