CALL TO ORDER

NEW BUSINESS

Project Site Review: 201 S. Salina Street (White Memorial Building). Jim Knittel (Dalpos Architects) presented the project to replace the 2nd-5th story windows on the White Memorial Building. He reported that the building was rehabbed in the 1980s and at that time interior storms were installed behind the original wood windows. The storms and windows are now inoperable. He noted that the owners plan to rehab a couple of the upper stories for residential purposes, which is driving the new project. The proposed project now calls for replacing all the upper-story windows with aluminum-clad, single-hung wood windows. These are full-frame replacements, but he noted that the brick molding around the windows will be retained. The board requested that the applicant submit a drawing that compares the dimensions of the old windows with the new. The board also requested a window survey to assess the condition of the windows.

DISCUSSION

Board membership. K. Auwaerter announced that Tim Bonaparte's term had expired and that he had asked not be considered for another term. The board confirmed the importance of having another qualified landscape architect on the board. K. Auwaerter noted that the mayor will request several names to consider. B. Haley requested that board members consider possible candidates and submit names to staff.
