

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
DOWNTOWN COMMITTEE OF SYRACUSE INC. TO ASSIST WITH
THE PERSEVERANCE PARK PAINTING PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Syracuse Urban Renewal Agency (hereinafter "SURA"), is the owner of a certain parcel of land commonly referred to as Perseverance Park being located at 216 South Salina Street, Syracuse, New York (hereinafter the "Property"); an

WHEREAS, the Downtown Committee of Syracuse, Inc. (hereinafter the "Downtown Committee") is a private, not-for-profit, professional downtown management organization, representing all property owners and tenants within the central business district; and

WHEREAS, The Downtown Committee undertakes programs to improve downtown's image, strengthen its economic base, increase its attractiveness, and assure that it's clean, safe, and accessible; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Committee has expressed interest in assisting SURA to paint the pavement at the Property with a colorful design (hereinafter the "Project"); with the intent to activate the space, and serve as an interim facelift for the park until final designs for a complete renovation can be implemented; and

WHEREAS, at no cost to SURA, the Downtown Committee would agree to donate paint, compensate the artist for his time, and organize and provide volunteers to paint the approved design at the Property.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that SURA hereby authorizes an agreement with the Downtown Committee to assist SURA with the completion of the Project at the Property insofar as it will compensate the artist, provide paint and other materials, organize and provide volunteers to paint, and provide such other services or materials as necessary to complete the Project; and

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the materials and services contemplated to be provided by the Downtown Committee to SURA as authorized by this resolution shall be provided without charge to SURA; and

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that SURA hereby authorizes its Chair to execute all documents necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution. The officers, agents and employees of the Agency are also hereby directed to proceed to do such further things, or perform such further acts and execute such other documents, as are necessary to implement this Resolution, upon those terms and conditions that are satisfactory to counsel for SURA.
