**Public Hearing Notice
City of Syracuse
CARES Act
CDBG-CV3 Funds**

Under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) dated March 27, 2020, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded additional funds on September 11, 2020 to the City of Syracuse \$1,676,401 in Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV3) funds to address needs caused by the novel COVID-19 pandemic.

HUD has approved a not less than 5-day public comment period for CDBG-CV funds. The comment period for CDBG-CV funds will begin on December 28, 2020 and end on January 5, 2021, which will allow the public to make comments or suggestions regarding COVID-19 related needs and use of these funds.
