Street Lighting Coordinator

This is a managerial position responsible for the maintenance and operation of the City-owned street lighting system. This incumbent will oversee contractors and City workforce, and will supervise clerical personnel in the delivery of a well-planned, cost-effective maintenance and operation program. Extensive contact with the public, consulting engineers, professional staff of local utilities, governmental agencies and City departments is required. Work is performed independently with general direction from the Commissioner of Public Works. Related work is performed as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

A) Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Construction Technology, or closely related field PLUS three (3) years of experience in the design and maintenance of urban street systems which included street lighting or the review of completed street lighting projects for contract compliance; or

B) Associate's degree in Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Construction Technology or closely related field PLUS five (5) years of experience in the design and maintenance of urban street systems which included street lighting or the review of completed street lighting projects for contract compliance; or

C) Master Electrician License PLUS seven (7) years of experience in the design, installation and maintenance of urban street lighting systems, three (3) of which were in a leadership/decision-making role; or

D) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (A), (B), and (C) above.
